## Free Vision Screening

According to the Vizavance website at <https://www.vizavance.org...>

- 80% of what a child learns in a normal classroom setting is through vision
- 70% of juvenile delinquents have an uncorrected vision problem
- 25% of school-aged children have a vision problem significant enough to impact learning
- only 15% of children will visit an eye care professional before entering school

On Tuesday, July 24th, Vizavance (formerly Prevent Blindness Oklahoma) is offering free vision screenings for everyone, from babies as young as six months of age through adults of any age. This is a great opportunity to have your school-age child or teen screened to see if they will need glasses before school starts.

The vision screenings will be available at the Piedmont library, 1129 Stout NW, from 10:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. No appointment is necessary. For more information, call 313-1485.
