No library card? Not a problem! Library cards are free at the Piedmont library. The library is located at 1129 Stout NW. For more information, call 373-9018.

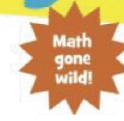
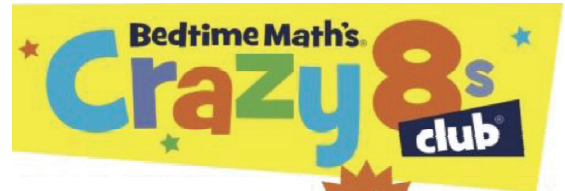
