A new license plate featuring the monarch butterfly will be available for preordering on November 1st online at www.nature.org/okmonarchs, on the Oklahoma Tax Commission's website, or in person at an event in Enid on November 1st. One hundred pre-orders of the tag within 180 days are required before the plates will be produced. The plate will cost \$38, \$20 of which will support The Nature Conservancy's conservation efforts.
